
## Description of this fund

The fund aims to provide an actively managed diversified portfolio of Australian and global equities, property securities, Australian and global fixed income, cash and alternative investments.

## What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Legg Mason Balanced fund:




## Example of how this applies to an investor

Craig had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Craig received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,311.00 (that is 13.11% of his initial \$10,000). Craig also paid \$0.00 in other charges. This gives Craig a total return after tax of \$1,311.00 for the year.

## Notes

- 1 The returns include any rebates of management fees which have been paid to qualifying investors.
- 2 The Manager's basic fee is estimated as it includes rebates of management fees for the period 26 September 2015 to 23 September 2016 paid to qualifying investors.
- 3 Other management and administration charges include charges by underlying fund managers who are not subject to New Zealand law. In these circumstances, AMP Wealth Management New Zealand Limited (AMP) is not able to verify that these charges have been calculated in accordance with the requirements of New Zealand law.
